### HONEST INSPECTION

- ☐ What am I pretending is "not that bad"?
- ☐ What truth am I avoiding?

### GUARD IT

- ☐ Where does temptation get into my life?
- ☐ Where does compromise get in?
- ☐ What voice or influence has too much access to me?
- ☐ What am I watching, listening to, thinking about, or consuming that is leaving me vulnerable?
- ☐ What would be the name of my gate(s)?
- ☐ How am I going to guard the gate?

*What we fail to guard,  
we leave vulnerable.*

### BUILD WHAT'S IN FRONT OF YOU FIRST

- ☐ What has God placed directly in front of me?
- ☐ What has been neglected while giving my energy elsewhere?
- ☐ What am I doing to protect what matters most?
- ☐ Do the people closest to me experience grace, mercy, forgiveness, and Jesus through me?
- ☐ What is one way I can intentionally take care of what is closest to me right now?
- ☐ What gets my first attention?

*Faithfully build what is in  
front of you first.*

### DON'T BUILD ALONE

- ☐ Who knows what is really happening in my life?
- ☐ Who is close enough to notice when I am getting tired?
- ☐ Who holds me accountable?
- ☐ Whose wall am I helping protect?
- ☐ Who needs encouragement from me right now?
- ☐ Who is on my rebuilding team?
